Restrictions	For Non-Erasmus students no access to human medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, law and psychology. Also admission to certain lectures in practical sports is restricted.

Grading system	We offer an overview of the <a href="#">grading system</a> used at FAU.
Language of instruction	The main language of instruction at FAU is German; in some fields English. The availability of English taught courses varies at every faculty, please check their websites for further information. We generally recommend a B2 level in the language of instruction; exchange students please check the instructions according to the corresponding agreement.
Language courses	A preparatory German course will be held before the start of lectures. The course fee and its credits <a href="#">can be found online</a> . During the semester period <a href="#">FAU language centre</a> offers language courses in different languages on different levels.
Transcript of Records	Exchange students can download their transcript of records via one of FAU's online platforms. They will receive further information during their stay.

Health insurance	German health insurance is obligatory. Accident insurance and liability insurance is highly recommended. All insurances should cover the whole stay in Germany.

	<p>Exempted from the obligatory German insurance are all students with European health insurance and EHIC.</p> <p>Travel health insurance: non-EU citizens should have travel health insurance at least valid until the start of lectures. Please be aware that international travel insurances are not sufficient and will not be approved by FAU and German authorities.</p>
Welcome week	FAU hosts <u>welcome weeks</u> for international students twice towards the beginning of each semester.
Buddy programme	International students can register for our <u>buddy programme</u> .
